

# Can I Get a DWI For Drinking and Riding a Bicycle in New Jersey?

- New Jersey law does not treat drinking and riding a bicycle as a DWI offense.
- A person riding a bicycle while intoxicated cannot be charged with a DWI.
- However, there are some legal consequences.



- If you are found riding a bicycle while drunk, you could be charged with disorderly conduct.
- You could face a jail term of six months or a fine of up to \$1,000.



- You could be taken into custody for being publicly intoxicated.
- If you violated traffic rules while drunk, such as not obeying traffic signals or not riding on the right, you could face serious legal consequences.
